


Love Bug Bite 2 is a tale about an upstart-superhero who tries to find his way.

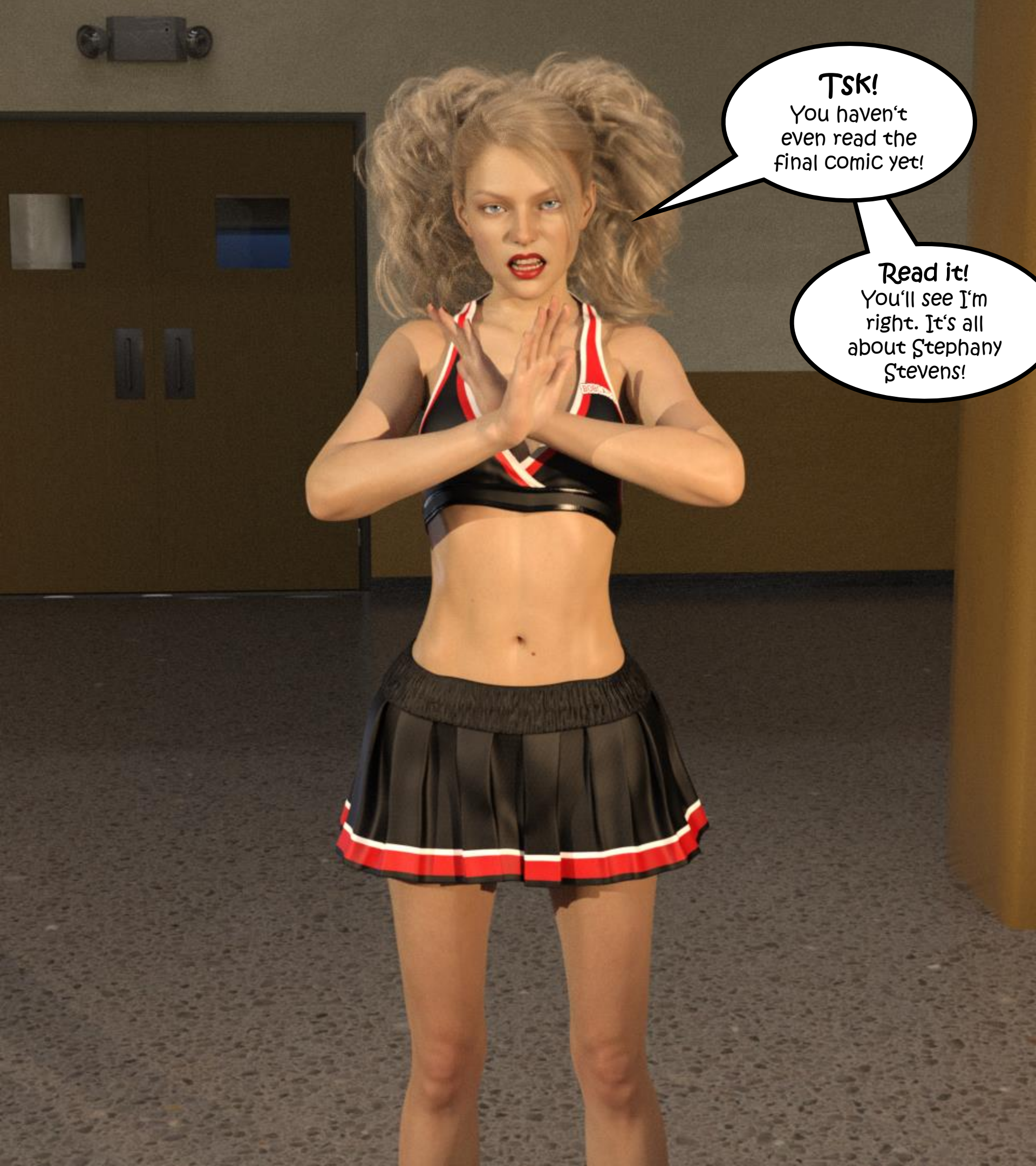
Finally, the thing ends with some strange questions.
